I am accessing an s2k database from a web app using .net. My server died and I had to reinstall s2k and now I am getting "Execute permission denied" on my stored procedures. The web app has not changed so I infer that something's wrong with the setup on the database. The connection string is as follows:

```
"Password=xxxx;Persist Security Info=True;User  
ID=WebUser;Initial Catalog=ScottWeb;Data  
Source=SRV;Trusted_Connection=Yes"
```

WebUser exists and has owner permission on the db.
