You can add the user to the database containing the proc and then grant execute permission to the user/role:

```
USE MyDatabase
EXEC sp_grantdbaccess 'MyDomain\MyUser'
EXEC sp_addrolemember 'MyRole', 'MyDomain\MyUser'
GRANT EXEC ON MyProcedure TO MyRole
```
