By default, anyone with a login can create a Package as the public role has execute permissions on sp_add_dtspackage stored procedure in msdb and the guest account is enabled in msdb by default so it depends on whether you have changed this or not.

But they don't need to be a sysadmin to create packages.

It's generally controlled through sp_add_dtspackage.
