I'm trying to create a certificate for use with a remote service broker instance.

```
Code:
create login sbLogin
create user Server_2_DB2_User from login sbLogin
```

```
create certificate Server_2_DB_2_User_Cert
authorization Server_2_DB_2_User
from file = 'c:\Server_2_DB_2_User_Cert.cer'
```

The last statement returns the following error:

```
Msg 15151, Level 16, State 1, Line 2
Cannot find the user 'Server_2_DB_2_User', because it does not exist or
you
do not have permission.
```

Note I am a sys admin on the sql server 2005 instance.

Please help.
