With SP 4, the SQL Trace API will scan for "password" and mask the text if password is found – as well as doing so for some security related stored procedures. Prior to that I think it may have limited it to some of the security system stored procedures (sp\_password, sp\_addlogin, etc). I'm not aware of any setting that turns this off.
