Hi all,

I have a SQL 2005 server running on SERVERA. I have the management studio installed on my desktop (Windows XP Pro SP2) and connect to the sql server using my regular domain login account (windows auth). This worked fine until I had to change my domain user account's password as it had expired (we have to change it every 90 days). Now, ever since then, I have been unable to connect to the sql server in management studio. I get:-

Login Failed for user ". Error: 18452

If I remote into the server and try to connect to sql it works fine (I am member of local admin group on the server)
