OK,

I figured it out. This returns the name of every database where the "guest" user has been activated (GRANT CONNECT):

```
use master
exec dbo.sp_MSforeachdb '
use [?]
select DB_NAME() + "." + permission_name
from sys.database_permissions
where grantee_principal_id = DATABASE_PRINCIPAL_ID("guest")
and permission_name = "CONNECT"
```
