To avoid having to pass this user specific ID via a parameter in the stored procedure, is it possible to create your own function like (like `suser_sid()`) or variable (like `@@SPID`) ?

This value would be passed from a Web Service (asp.net 2.0) in the connection string or something and could be referred to anywhere in the SQL code (SQL 2005).

Has anyone got a better solution than a SP parameter ?
