Jan,

If this database was restored from another server, the login that is the database owner (and therefore the login that becomes dbo) does not exist on the new server. If that is it, try changing the database owner by running:

```
ALTER AUTHORIZATION ON DATABASE <dbname> TO <loginname>
```

Even if the owner is a login (other than 'sa') with the same name on both machines, if the SID is different they do not actually match up, no matter what the SSMS makes it look like.
