This is a one boot-floppy-solution that gives you after a 10 second boot time full grafical access to NTFS-based WindowsNT/Windows2000 computers. It offers a Norton like Filemanager, a grafical Registryeditor and a grafical Usermanager with chance to change the password of any user. Compared to other solutions around it has direct support of almost any SCSI/RAID Controllers and many features others don't have like a integrated text/hex editor, unlocking of locked accounts, display of users that have an empty password
