

## Re: Security Delegation between IIS and SQL Server

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>2 Domain Controller  
>-DC1 is IIS with an ASP Web Application  
>-DC2 is SQL Server with the Database for the ASP Application  
>  
>Now i need Windows NT Authentication for the WebPage and for the Database,  
>but the ADO Connection doesn't work for a simple domain user.  
>  
>So what i have done:  
>- SQL Server uses only TCP/IP:1433  
>- SQL Server run under Domainuser XY  
>- With SetSPN registered a Service Principal Name for the SQL Server on Port  
>1433  
>- Domain Controllers are Default "Trusted for Delegation"  
>- Testuser - only member of Domain users - "Trusted for Delegation"  
>activated  
>- IIS Web App - only NT Auth.  
>- Testuser is a user in the SQL DB and has correct Rights  
>- ADO Connection String is:  
>>WITH objADODBConn  
>>.PROVIDER = "SQLOLEDB"  
>>.COMMANDTIMEOUT = 30  
>>.CONNECTIONTIMEOUT = 30  
>>.CURSORLOCATION = ADODB.adUseServer  
>>.PROPERTIES("INTEGRATED SECURITY") = "SSPI"  
>>.PROPERTIES("DATA SOURCE") = "DC2"  
>>.PROPERTIES("INITIAL CATALOG") = "MISAT"  
>>.PROPERTIES("PROMPT") = ADODB.adPromptNever  
>>.Properties("Application Name") = "MISAT\_WEB"  
>>End With

>Why does this not work - where else could be the problem - any suggestions?

Can you run Query Analyzer? Does this work embedding a user/password

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in the connection? Many issues are possible here...
