> *copied it to the correct directory. This fixed a bunch of*
> *problems. Then I started getting the 1202 msg. "Security*
> *policies are propagated with warning. 0x534 : No mapping*
> *between account names and security IDs was done." I looked*
> *up Microsoft Knowledge Base Article 248472. Went through*
> *the steps. I found out that this is not a user account,*
> *but it was the Power Users group. Does anyone know how to*
> *fix this? Thanks in advance!*
