We have several WIN 2000 SP4 machines in our office and I have recently noticed that some of the machines are freezing during critical times. I have looked in the event viewer logs under application and I have noticed there is a Userenv error and in the error it states (Windows cannot unload your registry file. If you have a roaming profile, your settings are not replicated. Contact your administrator.

DETAIL - Access is denied. , Build number ((2195)).

What happens is this service seems to take up all the system resources when it tries to write to the registry which in turn freezes the machine for around 30 sec.

Does anyone know about this service and how to disable it as I cannot let this continue specially when it causes the machines to freeze.
