

Re: How to restrict access to just Files, not Folders

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This should work. On the main security page give the group read/list/execute to the folder. Then go into "advanced" permissions and add the group again. Then select "folder and subfolder" in the apply onto box and check all the permissions other than full control and change permissions. What many seem to miss is that a user or group can be listed multiple times in advanced permissions. --- Steve

> be
> deleted, but either can files.
> If I unselect just Delete Subfolders and Files, and leave Delete, then
> both
> can be deleted. Same is true if just Delete Subfolders and Files is
> selected.
