\*I'm hosting a site that offers information via word documents. The developer has developed the site in ASP.

Some versions of Windows causes the "Enter network Password" box to pop up, but on others (like my XP Pro SP2 box) it does not. If you cancel the box, the document opens. I've tried various security settings on the files and containing folders, but none have worked.

What can I do to prevent the "Enter network Password" box to pop up on some pc's (eg. windows 2000, '98). Surely there must be some sort of underlying security option on the server?
