We have several W2K3 servers running IIS for development purposes. Often the developers have run the IIS lockdown tool. Once they do that I'm locked out of the machine, which for the moment, isn't the problem. The problem is that if I run a program like 'gettype.exe' or 'PSINFO.exe' the program just sits there. The machine never responds, if the machine wasn't there the command would time out, but these never do.

Has anyone seen this? Do you know what causes it and how to fix it?

(I am posting here because I figure you do scans of the machines on your networks and may have run into this.)
