Thanks for the reply. The GPMC scripts look like they just deal with GPOs as objects and never reference the settings inside them.

Otherwise, is there a way to have secedit export the local security policy currently configured as a template? That way I could bypass sec config & analysis and just do the comparison myself. These are all stand-alone systems, by the way.

Well, if not scripting it, is there at least a way to get MMC to recursively Export List from the security configuration and analysis? If not, this would be a great feature for MS to consider building-in to MMC or the snapins, since extracting data from them is a huge pain if there's lots of nested data.
