You are correct that the website requires windows integrated authentication.

I will have the user check his lan settings to see if there are any special proxy settings.

However, what doesn't make sense, is the fact that he can connect to ServerA with the FQDN with no issues. And ServerA is set up exactly the same way as ServerX(which is casuing the problem).
