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In AD, if the account object still exists one may look at the create timestamp.
The Owner attribute will often tell what account created the object, but this can be changed, and it can only say such as Domain Admins for some cases. As to accounts that no longer exist, or for what rights were given at creation, there is not much of anything in the running system that says (unless the rights have not been changed since creation, the fact of which one could theoretically determine from the security log if account management event success is audited).
