I would like to be able to create certificate requests that I can submit to my CA without using the CertSrv website because I am running sharepoint services on it and read somewhere (but not able to provide the link) that is not possible to have the Certificate Authority websites on a sharepoint machine.

My problem is that I need to create client certificate requests so that I can issue certs to individual users and use the certificates to authorise access to a website.

Can anyone tell me how I can create a valid client certificate request without using the CertSrv website?
