Config a Group Policy for the server or servers and use the "Services" branch of the computer account group policy. In here you can assign explicit permissions for any user to stop, paus, restart start etc each individual service. A small note, if its a custom/non-standard service you will have to create the policy from the machine with that service in order to see it.(i think). Anyhow, you can then use the resource kit tools "netsvc.exe" to run a batch or command line remotely to stop, start, query the specific service.
