I have shared folder on Windows 2003, when I check Domain Users permission is only Read & Execute, Read, List Folder Contents. Then I check in advanced and edit Domain Users permission – Create Folders and

Create Files are unchecked, but when I go to effective permission and select Domain Users there Create Folders and Create Files are checked.
