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The user would need to logoff and then logon the domain again to refresh their security token to reflect new group membership. The RK tool whoami /groups can show the contents of the logged on user. If problems continue you may have other issues such as domain controllers not replicating properly though with SBS I would think one domain controller would be the norm. Also if the user is logging on with cached domain credentials he will not have access to domain resources outside of his computer. Checking the security log on a domain computer can tell if a user is logging on with cached credentials. --- Steve
