This happens occasionally to our users who check a box somewhere to save their password. To fix it, while logged in as the user, go to User Accounts in the Control Panel. On the Advanced tab, choose Manage Passwords, and delete whatever is there.

If the user does not have sufficient priveleges to get into User Accounts, there's a "manage passwords" option on the login screen.

One of my users, a developer, keeps getting his account locked out, but I don't see anything in the domain controller security event log that helps me figure out why it's being locked.

He changed his password this morning, so maybe he has a service that uses his account.

Is there any way to track down where (machine or otherwise) his account is being locked from?
