



Re: possible to log when a domain user locks workstation?

audit when domain users log on and off the domain for the day, however, certain users are not logging off but simply locking the workstation at the end of the day and unlocking it the next day. These events do not appear in the security events log on the domain controller. Is there any way to log when a user locks a workstation either on the domain controller OR on the local machine?

Yes -- use group policy to enable logon/logoff success auditing on the XP workstations.

Basically locking and unlocking a machine doesn't touch the network so the domain controller will never know -- instead you have to gather together the audit logs from the workstations.
