The selection to have prompting as I understand it was built into the design when they still thought that they could work around the security context issues needed in order to allow the winlogon context to interact with the desktop session.

It turned out they could not in the timeframe allow to finish XP, and of course, by then this import feature was checked in and would have needed to be re-rev'd.

As it is it just makes for stubbed toes, as you discovered.
