I am trying to determine what is causing all of my W2K servers to be allowing "Null Sessions".

I have changed the "restrictanonymous" reg values to 2 and check the local policy settings on the servers per this ms doc:<http://support.microsoft.com/default.aspx?scid=kb%3ben-us%3b246261>

Evidently something is still causing these servers to respond to "Null Sessions". The Windows 2003 servers that have the same GPO settings do not respond to the Null Session requests?

Anyone ever see this before?
