It looks like the discrepancy is likely due to the fact that Computer#1 was formatted using NTFS, while Computer#2 is FAT32

>Win Explorer if I right click on a shared folder and
>select Properties, it brings up a window with 6 Tabs,
one
>of which is 'Security'. On computer#2, the same action
>brings up a window with only 4 tabs (missing Security
and
>Quota). Both computers are configured to run on my home
>workgroup.
>
>I feel as though the only explanation for the consistent
>differences in these two interfaces (and there are
>many!), has to be the result that computer#1 was once
>configured with Win 2K and part of a domain, while
>computer#2 was a clean install (reformatted hard
drive).
>While the 'Computer Name' tab of computer#1 shows no
sign
>of a domain, I don't think it 'has really accepted that
>fact!'
