checkboxes
> > > selected to force the permissions to be inherited by files in the
> folder?
> > > [Inheritance of permissions from the parent folder might have been
> > disabled
> > > on individual files or subfolders, and might need to be reset using

> > > method.]

> > > Also, I assume you are looking at the Security tab on the properties
of
> > the
> > > files and not at the Share permissions on the folder. Share
permissions
> > > only apply when the files are accessed through the network share and
do
> > not
> > > apply when accessing the files locally.

> > > It does sound like the permissions are not set up correctly. You
could
> > > either reexamine and/or post the permissions on one sample file, or
you
> > > could enable auditing for successful file access to that folder for
the
> > > Everyone group

> > > Be careful when using Deny. If you Deny the Everyone group, then
> Everyone
> > > is denied, including Administrators. [Though administrators can
always
> > take
> > > ownership of the files to fix the problem.]
