Windows XP has a firewall built into it with your internet connection. There is no way to change the settings for it that I know of, you can only disable it and enable it. You disable/enable the ICF by going to Control panel—Network connections— You then will see what you have named you ISP connection. RIGHT CLICK on this and hit properties, move along to the ADVANCED TAB and then you will see a little box of information and a check box to enable the firewall.
