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I have exactly the same problem. I downloaded the patch for WIN XP 32... tried to install, but got the cryptographic error. I deleted the catroot2 folder, and tried to reinstall. it went further that time, but still gave me the error. I went back and looked, and viola, the catroot2 folder was back.

>service pack 1.

>oh and one other thing, since i got this virus, i can't
>connect through msn without getting cut off. but AOL
works
>fine (that is how i am connected now). BUT if i look at

>network connections, it actually shows AOL as
disconnected.
