Windows XP Professional seems to be caching domain (Win2k) permissions locally and updating them on an unknown interval. Can I force the update to happen when I want it to?

When I make permissions changes in the Win2k AD they often take a long time to "take effect", though when that user logs onto a different client machine the permissions are correct. This disconnection makes me believe that the permissions are held locally. Is this true, if so what is the update interval for this permissions cache and can I force the update manually?
