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You need to add the other two PCs to the domain and you need to set the data folder to "shared"

If you intend to get rid of the domain, the only way to do that is to start from scratch. You cannot delete a primary domain.

>computers were on Win 98 connecting to a server on NT
>4.0. In order to transfer data from old server to one

>the new computers, I added one of the new computers to
>the NT domain. Now I'm unsure how to remove the domain
>restrictions off the new computer. I have successfully
>set up a new workgroup on the 3 new computers and they
>are seeing each other on the network. But they cannot
>access data (don't have permission) from the new
>server.
>It is still being overridden by the domain restrictions
>from NT. I can't even access the new server from NT
>server when signed on as administrator. Admin & domain
>admin are set up as full access, but it still wants a
>password for access. I'm not a savy IT pro & have been
