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I had a similar problem with some spyware (iGator/trickler...exe) that Add/Remove wouldn't affect. With some help from the McAfee techies, succeeded in deleting the file by restarting XP in Safe mode.

>First of all, go to Add/Remove Programs and uninstall the Newdot software (if it is listed) – then use either/both of the following programs to get rid of the rest of that spyware:
