"your account is configured to prevent you from using this computer"

I'm on a stand alone pc. I dont have him in the "deny logon locally" on security policy, nor is he a member of a group that's affected by that policy. I do have him in the user's group, which can log on locally. It seems that only members of the local administrators group can log onto this PC. He was able to log on recently, and I haven't messed with the local group policy.
