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Hey Ben,

Unfortunately the content advisor settings are a "per machine" setting and not a "per user" setting as this information is stored in HKEY_LOCALMACHINE. You would either have to manually lock down each user via restricted and/or trusted sites or use something 3rd party like "Net Nanny"
