Greetings --

When visiting such the sites be careful not to download/install their "free" viewers. ;-} To repair the current situation, uninstall the "viewer(s)" provided and then use Ad-Aware from www.lavasoft.de and SpyBot Search and Destroy from <http://security.kolla.de/> to clean up any residue. Both have free evaluation versions.

You should also try using MSConfig to see if something is being started each time you reboot.

Additionally, Look in the C:\Documents and Settings\All Users\Start Menu\Programs\Start Up and C:\Documents and Settings\username\Start Menu\Programs\Start Up folders, and in the system registry, primarily in the HKLM\SOFTWARE\Microsoft\Windows\CurrentVersion\Run and HKCU\SOFTWARE\Microsoft\Windows\CurrentVersion\Run keys.
