Hi Amir,

To remove the .NET Passport from a Windows XP account

1. Click "Start", and then click "Control Panel".
2. Double-click "User Accounts". If you cannot locate the "User Accounts" icon, do the following:
 - a. Click "Start", and then click "Run".
 - b. In the "Open" box, type "control userpasswords2" (without the quotation marks)
 - c. On the "Advanced" tab, click "Manage Passwords".
 - d. To remove an account, click an account, and then click "Remove".
 - e. Click "Close".
 - f. Sign out of MSN Messenger or Windows Messenger.
 - g. Right-click the Messenger icon on the taskbar, and then click "Exit".
 - h. Skip steps 3 to 5
3. Select your account name, and then under "Related Tasks", click "Manage My Network Passwords".
4. Click the .NET Passport you want to delete and "Passport. Net*(Passport)".
5. Click "Remove".
