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NIS, Has a user / admin feature to it, normally it inherits from the account under which you installed the product.

e.g. If you installed it when logged in as Dog, then Dog will tend to be the Admin for the NIS system. If it works on your wife's account open it up when she is logged in and Go to Options, and In there should be the settings (can't remember the name) which will allow you to manage the user account's who can admin NIS.
