If you are in a Workgroup setup you could try this :

Select Start...Run

type gpedit.msc

press enter/return

This will open a Microsoft Console for Group Security Policy on the Local Computer

Expand Administrative Templates from Computer Configuration.

Select Logon from the Admin Templates group

Here you will see a setting "Always use classic logon" if you enable this setting it should change the logon screen to classic Ctrl + Alt + Del. To enable the setting right click and select properties, then select enable and apply the setting.

Hope this does the trick
