> partitions. I want to lock down NTFS permissions a
> little tighter on both partitions. However, the Security
> tab does not appear under properties for the partitions
> or any sub-folders. Microsoft documentation says the
> Security tab can be turned on by going to Control Panel -
>> Appearance & Themes -> Folder Options. On the View
> tab, under Advanced settings, clear Use simple file
> sharing [Recommended].

> Appearance & Themes does not show up in my Control
> Panel. I found Folder Options, but there is no Advanced
> Settings on the View tab, and there is no option for Use
> Simple File Sharing on the View tab. The account I am
> logged in with is in the Administrator group. I also
> looked to see if I missed any Windows components under
> Add Remove Programs. Can anyone point me in the right
> direction. Thanks.
