> I'm running SP1, build 2600. I then went to download SP2. When I go to  
> install SP2, it says "Download Size 0kb, 0 minutes (downloaded; ready to  
> install)." Which implies - I think - that it's somewhere on my system. But  
> it's not, at least not in any place that I can find. The little icon that  
> signifies an update has been brought down is not there. So when I go to  
> install from WinUpdate, nada. Nothing happens. Can't download, can't  
> install.  
> Stuck at SP1. I know this process works because I just did it on my  
> laptop.  
> Any thoughts? I'm stumped.
