Note: This page shows the Internet Options Security Settings that the email you received from Microsoft is referencing. When the setting is set to Prompt, the Information bar appears and asks if you want to proceed with the download. When the setting is set to Enable, the component is downloaded and you are asked if you want to install it. When the setting is set to Disable, you see the information bar and are informed that your current settings do not allow the component to be downloaded.

I'll repeat what I suggested in my earlier response. This question really belongs in the Internet Explorer newsgroup. You've got a much better chance of getting your problem solved by one of the experts who frequents that newsgroup.
