This Google search shows that "chandir.dat" is a file related to BackWeb Lite. BackWeb Lite is an updater program usually found in HP computers (like for WildTangent games) and HP printer software. If this fits your situation, then BackWeb Lite is not malware. You can disable the automatic updating of HP software by either looking in the HP software or by using the System Configuration Utility.
