Find a friend who can download and make the bootable disk for you. Have them print the web page too.

Change your BIOS (hardware bios) to boot from that media first.. Insert it, turn off your PC, turn on your PC and go.

Your administrator user exists. You may have to be in Safe Mode to log onto it (since you have Home Edition – you cannot log into it in regular mode) and you have to know the password. The users name is "administrator" by default – it is different than your other users. You can reset the password using the disk above.

Otherwise – have a friend of yours create an Ultimate Boot CD.. I would have them make you both versions.. The *nix and the Windows one and see what you can do booting from those.
