Try this ... right click My Computer either on the Desktop or Start Menu and choose Properties.  
Click the Advanced tab, then the Settings button under Performance  
Click the Data Execution Prevention tab  
Put a mark next to ' Turn on DEP for all programs and services except for those I select '  
Click the Add button and add Access.  
Click Apply, OK. Close the System Properties window.

I have just swapped laptops from a Dell with XP Home to a Dell with XP Pro.  
When I try to open MS Access Applications on a network share that I have written and which worked ok on XP Home laptop, I get the above warning and cannot open the application. If I go to the location where the files reside ie c:\docs & settings\all users\shared docs\ then I can open the files ok.  
Other files such as MS Word or Excel are ok but then they are not executeable.

I have no Group Policy settings and at present and I am the sole administrator and user.

I assume that the problem, is associated with the applications not being digitally signed,

Can anyone offer any addvice on how to resolve this situation.
