> *To respond to Tom:*

> – *"because Java sucks"*

> – *Java's sandbox prohibits the applet making a socket connection to any address other than the originating server*

> – *JavaScript prohibits you setting a cookie to any other domain other than the domain the script was loaded from.*

> *Since we need an Applet for the performance, it must be hosted on the*

> *server collecting the data (not necessarily the DB server).*

No, I explained how to do that without having to put the applet or the JS on your own server. You can't send cookies to a separate site, but you can send URL's to a separate site. So instead of a cookie you put the data into a query parameter and send it to your site as the target of an image tag.
