I take it that this sort of thing:

iQA/AwUBQf2XY5S9Fk5okqe7EQInfwCgkOl+N

oPEUKoDspgGyp7bkoHZEHsAoKCY

fwnN5MwIkxhuXVoKLYSNNENT

=5Xvn

represents a big integer in base 64, with a checksum after the "=". (There are 26 lower-case letters available, and 26 uppercase, and a few other symbols are used). Does anybody know the details of this format?
